#### Fact Sheet

#### How do I reserve space for my child?

A deposit of \$50 per week or full payment is needed in order to reserve space. Register online at www.WhitinCommunityCenter.com or at the Member Services Desk.

#### How many spaces are available?

A total of 35 School Age children can attend each day. Space is reserved on a first come, first serve basis. All registrations are confirmed as they are received.

#### When do I pay my balance?

The cost and the balance due dates for the program are detailed on page 7. Balances are due ten days prior to start of the program.

#### Is there a sibling discount?

We offer a 5% sibling discount for children in the BVCP program with the lesser cost. See page 7 for pricing.

## Does my child need a membership to the WCC to attend BVCP Summer EDventure?

A membership to the Whitin Community Center is required at time of registration. Pay in full for a Youth Membership for \$117 at the Member Services Desk and the \$25 Joining Fee will be waived. Register for the school year now with deposit & receive included membership starting for the Summer.

#### Are there other discounts available?

Pay in full for a week of care before May 1st and receive a discounted rate of \$243.

## **Refunds/Cancellations**

Granted under the following conditions:

#### 75% Refund (less \$50 non-refundable deposit)

A documented medical condition that prevents the child from participating in the BVCP Summer EDventure week and the Center is notified at least 1 day prior to the start of the program.

#### 50% Refund (less \$50 non-refundable deposit)

Cancellation notice is given 30 days in advance to the start of the program.

## BVCP Summer EDventure (Kindergarten - 6th Grade)



BVCP Summer EDventure is full day co-ed themed weeks for children ranging from Kindergarten to 6th Grade. Children can participate in themed activities & exploration stations, including arts and crafts and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art & Math).
