Fact Sheet

How do I reserve space for my child?

A deposit of \$50 per week or full payment is needed in order to reserve space. Register online at www.WhitinCommunityCenter.com through your child's Daxko account or at the Member Services Desk. Or pay in full at time of registration.

Pay in full

Payment made by cash, check, or credit card in person or online

Deposit

Non-Refundable deposits of \$50 per week will secure your child's space at time of registration. A credit card will need to be on file for the payment of the remaining balance by auto draft 10 days prior to your child's start of their week. Cards on file will be charged 1 week at a time.

How many spaces are available?

A total of 35 School Age children can attend each day. Space is reserved on a first come, first serve basis. All registrations are confirmed as they are received.

When are final payments due?

All balances are required to be paid in full 10 days before week start. If you are paying by deposit your card must be on file and will be automatically charged 10 days prior to the start of the week. If remaining balance is not paid in full by that due date, your space is no longer reserved and we will offer it to the children on the wait list.

Is there a sibling discount?

We offer a 5% sibling discount for additional children in the BVCP program. See page 8 for pricing.

How do I get a Summer EDventure discount?

Very easy, we have an early bird discount BEFORE May 1st! Pay in full or pay by deposit with auto draft at time of registration to hold your space.



Does my child need a membership to the WCC to attend BVCP Summer EDventure?

A membership to the Whitin Community Center is required at time of registration. Pay in full for a Youth Membership for \$126 at the Member Services Desk and the \$25 Joining Fee will be waived.

Does my child have to swim during the day?

No. All Summer EDventurers can swim each day if they choose to do so. Pre-authorization is required on the child's Swimming Consent Form. BVCP Staff will take the children to & from the classroom to the pool area. Certified lifeguards and BVCP Staff will supervise the pool during the swim. Those children not swimming will have the opportunity to relax or work on activity pages in the pool area with BVCP Staff supervision.

What should my child bring/wear to the program?

EDventurers should wear comfortable clothes, shorts, T-shirts, and sneakers. Plan to bring sun block with consent form and a water bottle. All children should bring a nut free bag lunch every day. If a child decides to swim, they will also need a bathing suit and towel. Please leave valuables, large sums of money and electronic games/radios at home. Most importantly bring a great attitude and a smile.

Do I need to sign my child in & out of BVCP Summer EDventure?

Yes. Children have to be signed in everyday, and ALL CHILDREN MUST BE SIGNED OUT OF SUMMER EDVENTURE EACH DAY. The registration form provides space for additional adults who have authorization to pick up your child. If this needs to be changed at any time, a written note signed by the parent MUST be sent in indicating the change. Please call if your child is going to be absent from the program. If child is picked up after 6:00pm, a late fee will be applied. Please refer to your Parent Handbook.

What are the drop off & pick up procedures in place for this Summer?

All children should be escorted to classroom 2 upon arrival to the WCC for parent check-in. Parent must accompany child to classroom 2 each day. BVCP Staff will sign in each child to the program. Parents will pick up their child(ren) from their assigned classroom which will be confirmed after registration.

What about medications?

Prescription and over the counter medications can be administered at BVCP Summer EDventure. All medications must be in the original container with clear instructions and not expired. The medication form in the enrollment packet must be completed, signed, and returned to the BVCP Administrator prior to your child's first day of program. All medications are locked up and will be dispensed by our trained staff.

Refunds/Cancellations

Granted under the following conditions:

75% Refund (less \$50 non-refundable deposit)

A documented medical condition that prevents the child from participating in the EDventure week and the Center is notified at least 1 day prior to the start of the program. Documentation must be provided in writing from a medical professional (who is not a family member) stating there is a medical condition that prevents the child from attending BVCP Summer EDventure.
